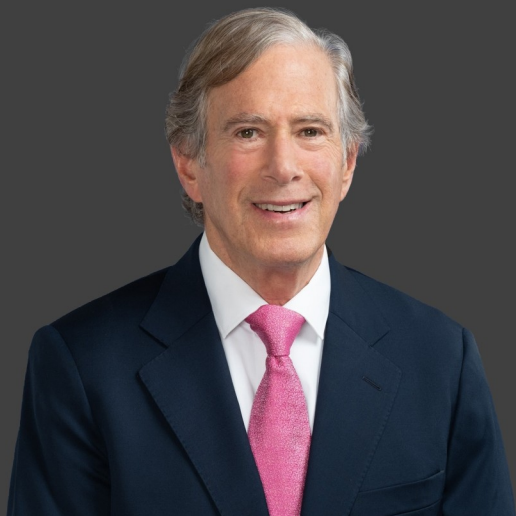

Bankruptcy:
